PUBLIC SPEAK OUT SESSION:

Loretta Lynn Gagetta, 140 Robin St., has concerns over property lines. A neighbor informed her that branch on her property fell and hit their vehicle. The tree is located against a guardrail on Lawrence St. right above her property. Her property ends 8 feet below Lawrence St. however the Township Ordinance states that she is responsible for the tree trimming on the Township right-of-way.

Sally Sahene, 206 Canterbury Ln., feels that the Township needs a noise ordinance. The Solicitor and Chief of Police both say that a noise ordinance is very hard to enforce. Also, complains that the traffic going into Dunkin' Donuts extends all the way onto Rt 30.

Lana Starcher, 180 Central Ave., has a neighbor that parks a large box truck in their driveway which is against Township ordinance. Spoke to police, the resident was cited once before and it was thrown out by the Magistrate, who stated that the ordinance is no longer enforceable.

Connie McHugh, 445 London Ave., complaints about the vacant house located at 872 Sylvan Ave.

Gena Romano, 431 Woodland Rd., wanted an update on the alley behind Woodland Rd. President Grimes has contacted several officials and states that the situation is being reviewed daily.

Dept. is requesting use of the Community Center for the site of the Summer Lunch Program. Other sites include: St. John's Lutheran Church, Green Valley, E. ENGINEER'S REPORT:

Township Engineer, David Gilliland, reports that there is a new Pennsylvania law that went into effect April 25, 2011, that permits municipalities to deny building permits to residents who are delinquent with taxes, refuse, and other municipal fees.

CDBG Grant applications are due May 24th, 2011 at the TCVCOG. The list of projects being applied for are: Markle St. retaining wall, Mason Alley hillside stabilization, reconstruction of 3 streets, demolition of 5 houses, re-paving basketball courts in Crestas Park.

He said they told him there is no money, so they suggested sending a cost sheet and list of the worst streets in the Township so they can try to work with us when the money comes in. It would cost over \$500,000.00 to fix just 10 streets.


